- Violin I:** Treble clef, 3/4 time. First entry at measure 1 with a *f* dynamic.
- Violin II:** Treble clef, 3/4 time. First entry at measure 1 with a *f* dynamic.
- Viola:** Alto clef, 3/4 time. First entry at measure 1 with a *f* dynamic.
- Violoncello:** Bass clef, 3/4 time. First entry at measure 1 with a *f* dynamic.
- Double Bass:** Bass clef, 3/4 time. First entry at measure 1 with a *f* dynamic.

Detailed description of the musical score for measures 30-35:
   
- **Flute (Fl.):** Starts with a whole rest at measure 30. In measure 31, it plays a sixteenth-note triplet with dynamic *f*. This continues through measures 32 and 33. In measure 34, it plays a whole note with dynamic *p*, followed by rests in measures 35 and 36.

- **Trombones (Tbn. and B. Tbn.):** Play a chord of two notes starting in measure 34 with dynamic *p*.
   
- **Timpani (Timp.), Triangle (Tri.), Harp (Hp.):** All have whole rests throughout measures 30-36.
   
- **Violins (Vln. I and II):** Play a sixteenth-note triplet (*f*) in measure 30. This continues through measures 31 and 32. In measure 33, they play a quarter note. In measure 34, they play a whole note, and have whole rests in measures 35 and 36.
   
- **Viola (Vla.):** Whole rests throughout measures 30-36.
   
- **Violoncello (Vc.) and Double Bass (Db.):** Play a quarter note in measure 30. In measure 31, they play a half note. In measure 32, they play a quarter note. In measure 33, they play a quarter note. In measure 34, they play a quarter note, and have whole rests in measures 35 and 36.
